

Baxenden & District Golf Club Competition Rules

COMPETITION RULES

(Breach of a rule automatically incurs disqualification)

- 1. All competitions will be played by the Rules of Golf as determined by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews
- 2. NO MEMBER WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN ANY COMPETITION UNLESS SUBSCRIPTIONS AND FEES (IF ANY) HAVE BEEN PAID UP-TO-DATE.
- 3. Before commencing play, each competitor must purchase a Competition Card on which his/her score must be returned and also enter his/her name on the Competition Sheet. Members entering for sweepstakes only must take out and mark up a Competition Card.
- 4. Any member with a handicap given by this club may mark a card for a competitor in any Club Competition.
- 5. Practice is allowed on Competition Days on the PRACTICE GROUND ONLY.
- 6. Play in Saturday competitions may continue until 9pm
- 7. In the event of there being fewer than nine entrants in a competition, the competition will be void.
- 8. On Club Competition Days non-competing players must allow competitors to go through.
- 9. In the event of a tie:-
- a) in a 36-hole Medal Competition, it shall be decided on the lowest score in either round. If equal, the tie should be decided on the score in the last 9 holes, 6 holes or 3 holes in that order.
- b) In an 18-hole Medal Competition, it shall be decided on the lowest score in the last 9holes, 6 holes or 3 holes in that order.
- c) In any Stableford Competition, where a tie is decided on the lowest score against bogey in the last 9 holes, 6 holes or 3 holes in that order.
- d) In any Handicap Medal Competition, where a ties is decided on the last 9 holes, 6 holes or 3 holes, the handicap allowance shall be half, one-third or one-sixth of the competitor's handicap as the case may be.
- 10. Any member or visitor who is a prize winner and does not attend the presentation without an apology for absence will not receive their prize.
- 11. Selected board prizes will have a handicap limit of 28.
