



Baxenden & District Golf Club Rules

1. Competitors are not allowed to alter their tee-off time on the day of play
2. All membership matters are dealt with by the Secretary. He should be contacted in the first instance.
3. A member's age on 1 January of the forthcoming season determines their category of membership.
4. Subscriptions are payable, in advance, on 1st January and are required to be paid by 31st January; Any member whose subscription is unpaid on 31 January shall cease to exercise the privileges of membership and his/her name may be erased from the books of the club. New members must pay their subscriptions and entrance fee within 7 days of their confirmation of membership.
5. Juniors under 18 years of age are admitted but, whilst at liberty to use the Dining Room, they are prohibited from using the Gentlemen's Clubroom.
6. Independent visitors are charged £20 per day but are not allowed to play on Saturdays, Sundays or Public Holidays. Visitors signed in by and playing with their introducing member are charged £10 on weekdays and £10 on Saturdays, Sundays or Public Holidays. A member is allowed to introduce up to three visitors at any one time. Visitors are limited to six games per year.
7. Spouses and supervised children of members are allowed free access to the club's facilities on a social basis. A house charge of 50p is payable in respect of non-playing visitors.
8. Ladies and mixed couples must, on request, allow other members to go through.
9. Practice must, on no account, interfere with or hinder in the slightest any game being played by men and/or ladies.
10. If players 'cut in' at any point on the course they have no standing and must not interfere with any game over the normal course. Without being asked they must invite such a game to go through.
11. Aluminium or other metal tee pegs which could cause damage to cutter blades must not be used.
12. Local rules, as may be deemed expedient, will be posted up from time to time; conditions thus imposed must be strictly complied with during play. Play your ball as it lies off tee beds.
13. The Club does not accept responsibility for the security on Club premises of the personal effects of any person. Members are strongly urged to insure their golfing equipment, etc.
14. Golfers are required to be properly dressed and equipped. Basic equipment consists of a bag of clubs, a supply of golf balls and tees and proper golfing shoes. Overalls, jeans, tee-shirts, vests, Wellingtons, training shoes, plimsolls and sandals are not allowed on the course although shorts, if properly tailored, may be worn. Golf shoes, Wellingtons, overalls, jeans, tee-shirts, vests, outdoor coats and headgear must not be worn in club rooms.
15. There should be a maximum number of 3 players in Singles matches and 4 players in Four-ball play, playing at one tee-off time. Under no circumstances, in competition or friendly matches, should there be more than this number.
